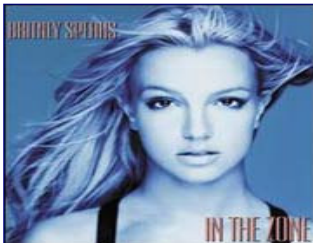


THINK OUTSIDE THE BOX...

- Eminem - *promotes very graphic, disturbing behaviors*
 - slitting his mother’s throat
 - dropping out of school
 - doing drugs
 - sodomizing women
 - suicide



- Britney Spears – *endorses a harmful lifestyle to young girls*
 - the “proper” way to dress is to wear scantily clad clothing
 - premarital sex has no consequences
 - lesbianism is an acceptable way of life
 - stripping is a great way to receive attention

- Grand Theft Auto – San Andreas & Halo 2
 - *video games that demonstrate how violence is the way to solve problems*
 - players filling the air with blood as they kill people with baseball bats and guns
 - glamorize drive-by shootings & drug dealing
 - gamers have sex with prostitutes
 - body parts are used as weapons

- Premarital sex is safe and everyone’s doing it

- Using violence can solve your problems

- one in four sexually active teens contract a Sexually Transmitted Infection (STI)
- every 8 minutes another teen dies from drinking and driving
- teen rape and suicide are at an all-time high
- a record number of teens are committing murder

The show includes face-to-face interviews with school shooters such as Jamie Rouse from Tennessee and Michael Carneal from Kentucky, as well as stories from several victims of violent crimes. Tina has recently written a chapter in the reality-based devotional book, “Fifty,” which describes how the media has a major influence in how teens think and behave. In addition, she is a contributing writer/mentor for The Student Operated Press which generates millions of readers every week on www.thesop.org.

Tina has conducted hundreds of radio and television interviews nationwide, such as the Alan Colmes National FOX radio show, KABC (ABC NEWS – Los Angeles), and the American Perspective Radio Show. This message has also been featured in different publications, such as Interlinc, Plugged-In magazine and numerous music magazines.

Tina has reached thousands of students, parents, youth advisors, school administrators and communities as a whole for the past five years, covering cities throughout the United States, Bolivia and Africa.

SEMINAR DESCRIPTION

She will also analyze video games such as Grand Theft Auto – Vice City (the top selling game for PlayStation II), San Andreas, Halo 2, and Doom. In addition, Tina will discuss the dangers of pornography, as well as cheat codes in video games, chat rooms on the Internet, and the inaccuracy of web filters.

During this live, interactive presentation, Tina will show video footage, play music clips, and examine lyrics and quotes from various music groups and celebrities. She will also share a few stories of how school shooters were sentenced to life in prison without parole, show photos of how cocaine physically affected a drug addict (over a period of years), and share an urgent message from Ted Bundy about the dangers of pornography (taped just prior to his execution). In addition, Tina will share her first-hand experience about working in Hollywood for the past eight years and reveal the latest and hottest positive choices in entertainment!

Tina has spoken to thousands of people at national conventions, music festivals, school assemblies, parent/teacher conferences, youth events, and churches. She challenges her audience to take a stand against supporting violent, obscene entertainment.
